Life Path - What You're Here to Learn

Your life path number is the most important and powerful number in your chart, as it is the contract of development you agreed with your spirit guide before this lifetime. Your life path is your purpose, because it represents the areas you chose to develop in this incarnation. Think of your life path as the king of your kingdom, with all the other numbers in your chart serving that king. Achieving this path is not easy. It is not a talent in itself, it carries your potential for talent. If you were not up to the task, it would not appear in your life path. It is your lesson and your chosen evolution for this incarnation. You will encounter obstacles on the journey towards this path, and that is the point. Your ultimate goal in this life is to overcome the difficulties and transcend them.

Your individual life path is made entirely personal by the sub-lessons and all the other numbers in your chart. They influence your flavour, like the choice of herbs in a meal.

Life Path Number 6

This path centres on being a visionary of the ideal, a dreamer of a utopian world, and a manifestor of those ideals on earth. It calls for practical action to help those who need it most, and for embodying the change you want to see, creating more light to counterbalance the darkness in this world. These ideals are held without overriding or ignoring the life and wellbeing of groups, belief systems, or ways of life that differ from your own.

The state of the world can feel disappointing to an idealistic visionary. When ideals are unrealised, sadness can arise. The learning focuses on not using ideals as the benchmark for happiness and emotional wellbeing. There is a tendency to judge yourself and others for not reaching perfection, which brings great unhappiness. This world is a school of dark and light that evolves our souls through experience. If the world were already perfect, there would be no reason for you to be here. The earth is a hard school.

Perfectionism can drive overachievement through constant self-judgement, with standards that feel impossible to meet. Keeping the big picture in view, rather than getting stuck in petty detail, is essential. Small imperfections can be judged harshly, which can ruin or make you miss your successes.

Universal, positive nurture is a key lesson, offering care without discrimination. Compassion, care and generosity are directed especially toward those who are vulnerable or struggling in close relationships, the community, and the wider world. When perfectionism and judgement take over, nurture can become fanatically idealistic and unhealthy.

This path is about nurture, with clear boundaries needed to safeguard mental and physical health and wellbeing. Number 1 - Strong (6)

Your core numbers, namely Life Path, Birthday, Expression and Soul Urge, exert the strongest influence. Intensifiers are added characteristics that modify these core numbers. Strong, weak or average intensifiers point to the possibility of additional strengths and weaknesses in character. Repeated numbers in the birth name indicate a potential strength in that area, accrued from previous life experience. When numbers are absent, this points to a karmic lesson, a weakness or obstacle, present because the missing energy has not been experienced in previous lives. Clings to a victim mentality, using perceived negative treatment by individuals to justify irresponsible, unethical, and vengeful actions. Self-serving leadership is covertly hidden, used to misinform, while publicly proclaiming well-being for all. Capable of influencing and leading others towards their destruction.
